



Overview of lectionary readings (year B) and themes 2011-2012

The Revised Common Lectionary (RCL), used by many denominations across the world, is a common framework from which to read the Bible on Sundays. The RCL provides a three-year cycle offering a reading from the Old Testament, a psalm, a reading from a Gospel and a reading from one of the letters or Acts each week.

The ROOTS resources usually focus on one of the readings, exploring a common theme across the two magazines. In the Adult & All Age magazine, an Alternative thread of sermon notes on another of the readings is shown in italics.

We offer alternative resources on the website when the readings in the Church of England's Common Worship Lectionary differ from the RCL.
