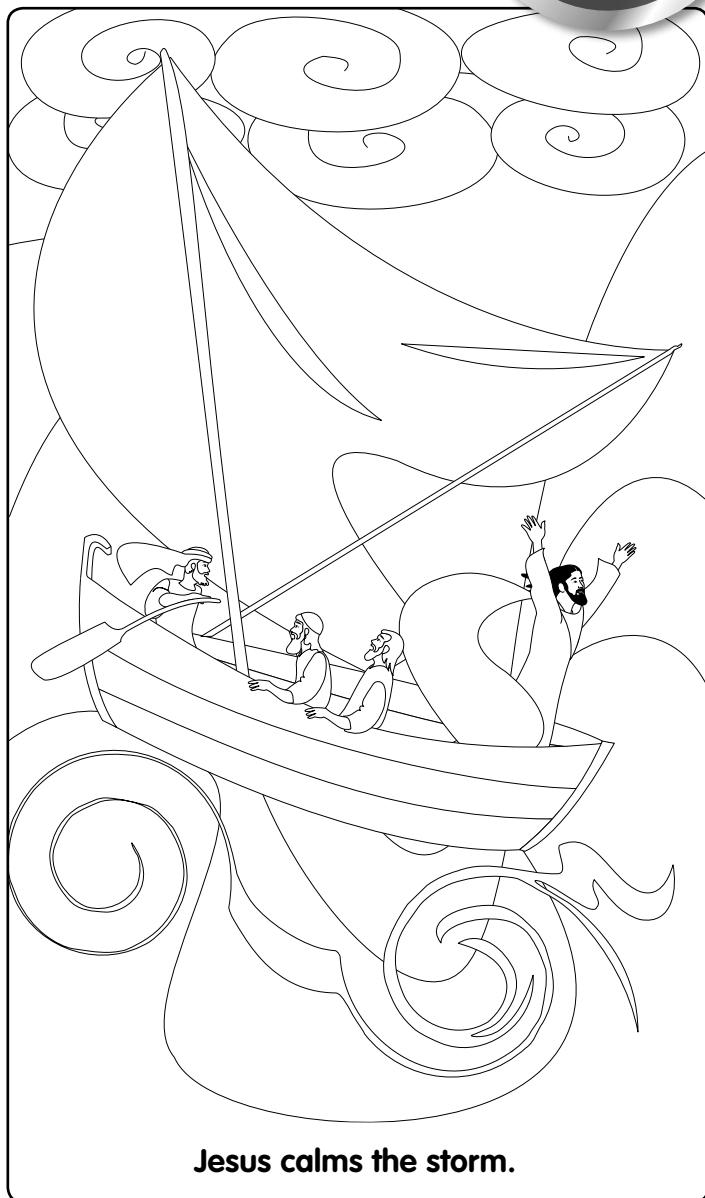

scared?



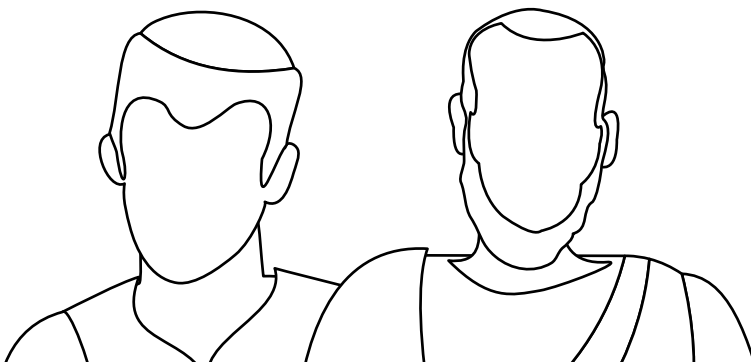
Jesus calms the storm.
