

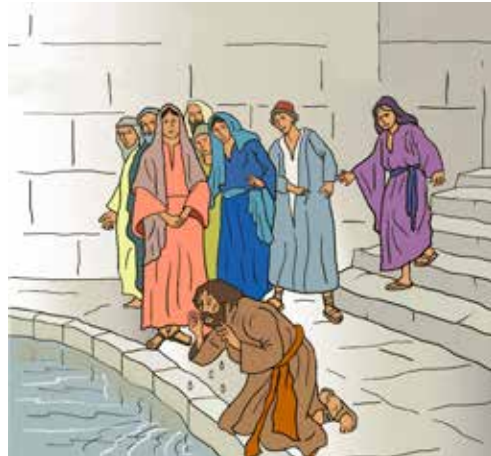

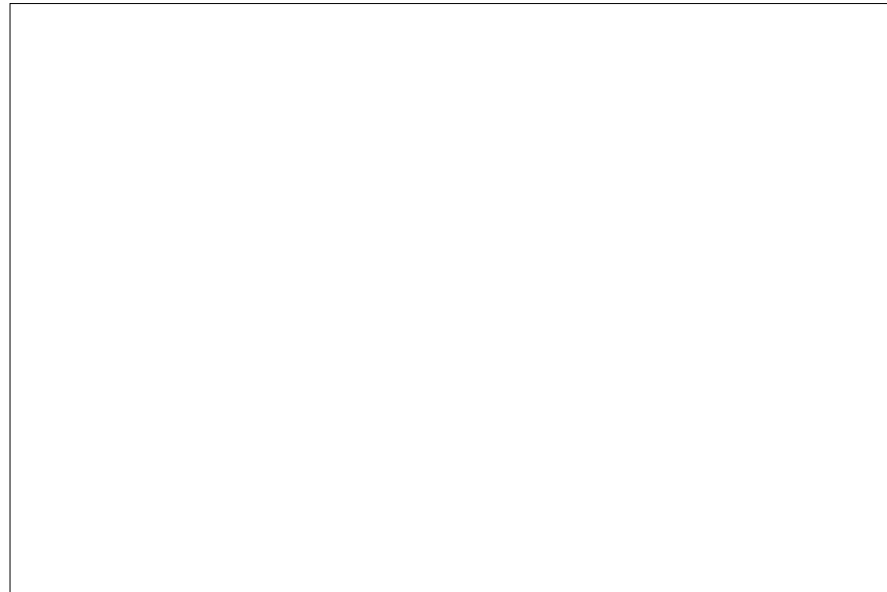
John 9.1-41
