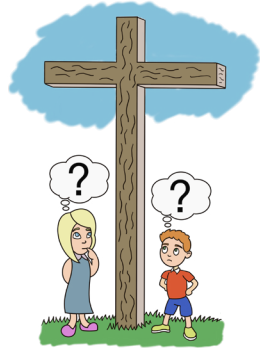
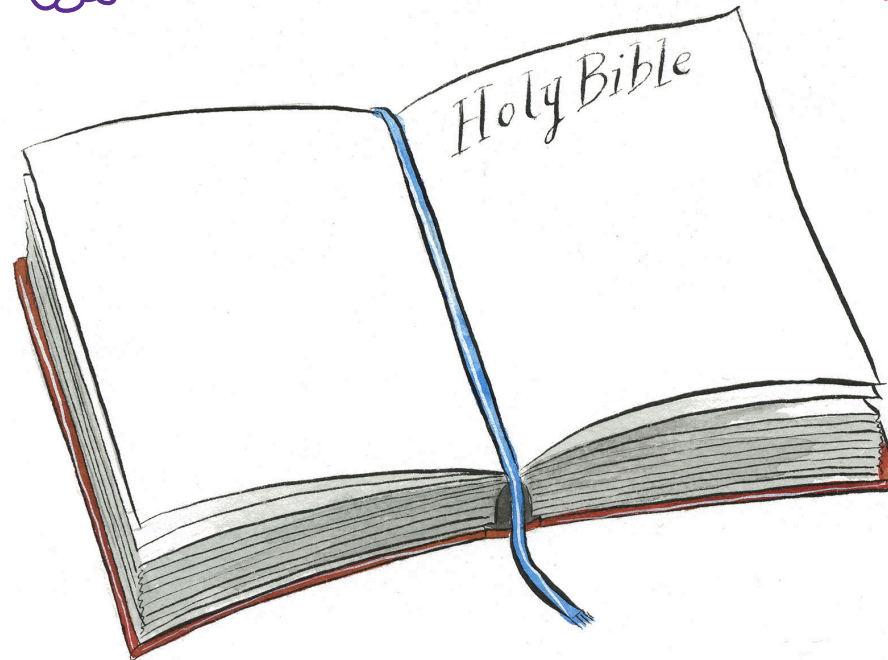
Jesus explains that being a follower will not always be easy, and that whoever puts themselves first will end up coming last.

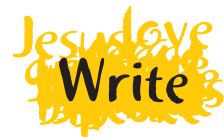


Family time
