ohn the Baptist was in prison, so now it was up to Jesus to tell people the good news of God. ③ He came to Galilee, saying, 'The time has come. The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news.' ③

As Jesus walked along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw two fishermen. They were brothers, Simon and Andrew. He watched as they cast a net into the lake and waited. After a while, the net seemed to get heavy; it was full of fish, wriggling and jumping. The two men began to drag the net ashore. As they did so, they looked up and saw a man standing watching them. 'Who is that?' Andrew asked Simon, puzzled. Jesus drew nearer and looked straight at them. 'Follow me and I will make you fish for people,' he said. Immediately, they left their nets and followed Jesus. 😵
