Additional challenges during the event

Depending on volunteers and resources, you can offer some or all of these additional challenge activities to do near to the related egg poster (not too close or it won't make finding the egg poster enough of a challenge), making available the relevant craft materials.



Facilitate a game of 'Pin the tail on the donkey'. There are many free versions available for you to print off from the internet. Don't forget a blindfold and sticky tack.





Hide chocolate coins around the area for the children to find. You will need to hide more coins as the time goes on.





Provide a large pile of rocks for people to interact with. Remembering people who have loved you and made sacrifices for you, use stones to make a pattern or cairn as a monument.





Make an origami palm leaf from coloured paper. https://www.youtube.com/ atch?v=jnFrdbWeMwE,https:// rumble.com/v1mzs4m-howto-make-an-origami-palmleaves-easy-and-step-bystep-tutorial.html





Have some bread and juice in a cup available as a visual display of communion. Ask: As you look at the cup and bread, what do you think Jesus' friends thought when he said this? Can you imagine yourself around the table listening to Jesus?





Imagine you are the first to discover the empty tomb. What would your face look like? Create a dramatic freeze frame of the scene and take a photo. The church volunteer could offer to take photos of the scene for the families on their phones.





Ask the families to talk together about a special meal they've enjoyed with friends or family.





Provide craft sticks, glue and decorations like buttons, yarn, sequins or loom bands to make a decorated cross. https://happyhomefairy.com/

Encourage the families to share a story about something good that has happened, something they are thankful for, perhaps an answer to a prayer. Provide pens and sticky notes and a wall or table where they can stick them. Ask the families to write (or draw) their good news story on a sticky note and add it to a good news display.
